

**By-law No. 2010-064**  
**SCHEDULE F - SNOWPLOUGH OPERATORS**

<b>Applicable to</b>	Every Snowplough Maintenance Contractor that operates or carries on conducting, operating, maintaining, keeping or engaging as a “Contractor” or an “Employee” of the Contractor who performs their duties on public and private property or is required to move place to place on public and private property to perform their duties for the purpose of snow clearing, snow plowing, salting, sanding, snow removal or other related use for hire.
<b>Definitions</b>	<p>“<b>Contractor</b>” means a person who makes an agreement with another to do a piece of work, retaining in himself control of the means method and manner of producing the result to be accomplished.</p> <p>“<b>Employee</b>” or “<b>Driver</b>” means any person working in or for the licensed Contractor.</p> <p>“<b>Operate</b>” means to manage, work, maintain, put or keep in a functional state any business.</p> <p>“<b>Snowplough Maintenance Contractor</b>” means a business which provides property maintenance services including but not limited to plowing, shovelling, salting, sanding or otherwise removing of snow or ice.</p> <p>“<b>Safety Standards Certificate</b>” means a safety standards certificate issued pursuant to sections 88 to 100 of the <i>Highway Traffic Act</i>.</p> <p>“<b>Vehicle</b>” or “<b>Equipment</b>” means a motor vehicle, trailer, traction engine, farm tractor, road building machine, and any vehicle or equipment drawn, propelled or driven by any kind of power, including muscular power, but does not include a motorized snow vehicle or street car.</p>
<b>Exemptions</b>	<p>Town or County Staff and/or their agents as approved by the Municipality or County.</p> <p>Persons performing a neighbourly service to not more than five (5) properties.</p>
<b>Annual Licence Fee</b>	\$50.00 per vehicle/operator
<b>Application Circulated to</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Municipal Law Enforcement Department</li> <li>2. Ontario Provincial Police</li> </ol>
<b>Special Conditions</b>	<p>In addition to the General Regulations set out in Part 4 of this By-law, the following conditions apply to every Snowplough Operators Licence:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. No licence shall be issued unless the applicant: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) is at least eighteen (18) years of age;</li> <li>(b) if a corporation, association, or partnership file copies of the letters of the incorporation, or incorporating documents, names, and address of each member of the partnership;</li> <li>(c) has provided proof of insurance for each Vehicle to be used in accordance with the requirements as indicated in Certificate of Insurance;</li> <li>(d) has registered each Vehicle or equipment used in the business by filing a list indicating for each Vehicle or equipment, the make, model, year and/or the Vehicle plate number or where a Motor vehicle plate is not issued pursuant to the <i>Highway Traffic Act</i>, the vehicle identification number;</li> <li>(e) has provided, where applicable, a Safety Standards Certificate for each motor vehicle to be used in business;</li> <li>(f) has submitted a complete application form as prescribed;</li> <li>(g) has provided a list of each driver or Employee;</li> <li>(h) has paid the fees in accordance with this Schedule; and</li> <li>(i) has provided proof of applicable insurance coverage.</li> </ol> </li> </ol>
