



Jumpstart Learn To Skate Program Frequently Asked Questions

What is Jumpstart?

Canadian Tire Jumpstart is a national charitable program that helps financially disadvantaged kids participate in organized sport and recreation. Jumpstart will help cover registration, equipment and/or transportation costs.

What does the “beginner” level mean?

The beginner level would be the perfect class for a child that has not been on skates before or has only been on them a few times. In the beginner level, children will learn basic skating skills including balance & posture; falling down and getting up; marching on the spot, forward and in rotation; learning to stop; two foot jumps, and forward skating.

What does the “Novice” level mean?

The novice level would be ideal for those that have been participating in public skating but with very little skill development. In the novice level, children will learn skating skills including forward T-Push; skating backwards; crossovers; forward glide transferring weight; and backward 2 foot glide.

What is the process for receiving financial assistance for Registration / Equipment?

If you require financial assistance for the registration fee, equipment, or both, your application will be forwarded to the Jumpstart foundation representative here in Collingwood. You will then be contacted by Canadian Tire Jumpstart to make arrangements for equipment fitting or registration payment.

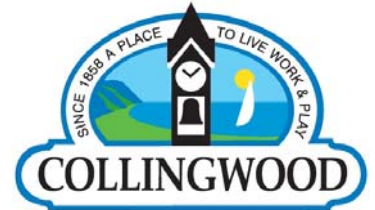
