Importance of a Clear Contract

- A detailed scope of work
- Project timelines
- Payment terms
- Change order procedures

A strong agreement should also:

- Clarify responsibilities
- Outline performance expectations

Start Early

Engage a building code consultant as early as possible in your project. Early involvement helps:

- Streamline planning
- Reduce the risk of delays or rework
- Guide the project toward creative, code-compliant, and cost-effective solutions

Collaboration Is Key

- Any changes must be reviewed by the Town's Building Division before proceeding
