## Outdoor Water Restrictions

Residents are reminded of the Town's year-round outdoor water restrictions (By-law no. 2016-066). The intent of this By-law requirement is to promote water conservation, but it is particularly important to limit outdoor water use during the summer months to ensure peak water demands in Town can be met with the existing capacity of the Town's drinking water treatment plant. Reducing outdoor water usage helps ensure water is available for essential purposes and emergencies, such as firefighting

- **Properties with odd-numbered addresses can water on odd-numbered calendar days.**
- **Properties with even-numbered addresses can water on even-numbered calendar days.**

Residents are encouraged to water their lawns between 7:00 a.m. - 9:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. - 9:00 p.m.

Please ensure your automated watering systems are set to reflect the correct watering day for your residence.

## Property Owners

**Your 2024 final property tax bill is enclosed. The total amount is payable in two installments, due on August 16 and October 18, 2024.**

Your property tax bill includes taxes levied by the Town of Collingwood, the County of Simcoe and the Provincial education levies.

### Tax Dollar Breakdown

Based on a sample home assessed at \$350,000, the total taxes payable will be \$4,230, broken down as follows:

Town Portion: \$2,646.25  
County Portion: \$1,048.25  
Education Portion: \$535.50

### Tax Reductions

Pending tax reductions from Assessment Appeals, Requests for Reconsideration, Special Amended Notices, or Section 357, reductions will be processed after the final tax bill.

### Change of Address or New Owner

The Town will issue tax bills to the mailing address provided by your solicitor, or to the address indicated on the transfer deed. If a mailing address has not been specified, the tax bill will be sent to the property address by default. If you wish to change your mailing address, you must notify the Treasury Department in writing, or by e-mail at [taxes@collingwood.ca](mailto:taxes@collingwood.ca)

### Penalties and Interest

To avoid penalty and interest charges, payment must be received by the Treasury Department on or before the due date. Interest will be added at the rate of 1.25% on the first day of each month for as long as the account is outstanding.
