



2022 Final Maximum Campaign Expense and Contribution Limits – Council

In accordance with the Municipal Elections Act, the Clerk shall give candidates a preliminary calculation of the maximum campaign expenses at the time of filing the nomination paper, based upon the number of electors on the Voters' List as September 15 in the 2018 municipal election, including changes made that day.

On or before September 25, 2022, the Clerk shall give a "final" certificate of the applicable maximum campaign expenses to each candidate. The number of electors to be used in this final calculation is to be the greater of the number of electors from the September 15, 2018 Voters' List or the Voters' List as of September 15, 2022 including changes made on that day. The number of electors has increased from 18,781 in 2018 to 21,755 in 2022.

Accordingly, the following is a summary of the final maximum campaign expense limits for each applicable position on Council. Individual certificates will be provided to each candidate in accordance with the Act. The Clerk's calculations are final.
