



## 2022 Preliminary Maximum Campaign Expense and Contribution Limits – Registered Third Party Advertisers

Upon registering a third party advertiser, the Clerk shall calculate the applicable maximum amount of the expenses for the purposes of Section 88.21(6) of the Municipal Elections Act, as of the filing date, using the number of electors determined from the Voters' List from the previous election as it existed on September 15, 2018.

Accordingly, the following is a list of the “preliminary” maximum campaign expense limits for Registered Third Party Advertisers:

### Maximum Campaign Expenses

Registrant	Base Rate	+ Per Elector	# Electors	Total
Third Party Advertiser	\$5,000	\$0.05	18,781	\$5,939.05

### Maximum Expense – Parties (10% of Maximum Campaign Expenses Limit)

Registrant	Total Maximum Campaign Expense	Total (10%)
Third Party Advertiser	\$5,939.05	\$593.91

As required under Section 88.19 (13) of the Municipal Elections Act, on or before September 25, 2022, the Clerk shall calculate the final maximum expenses permitted for each office for which nominations have been filed and the Clerk's calculations are final.
