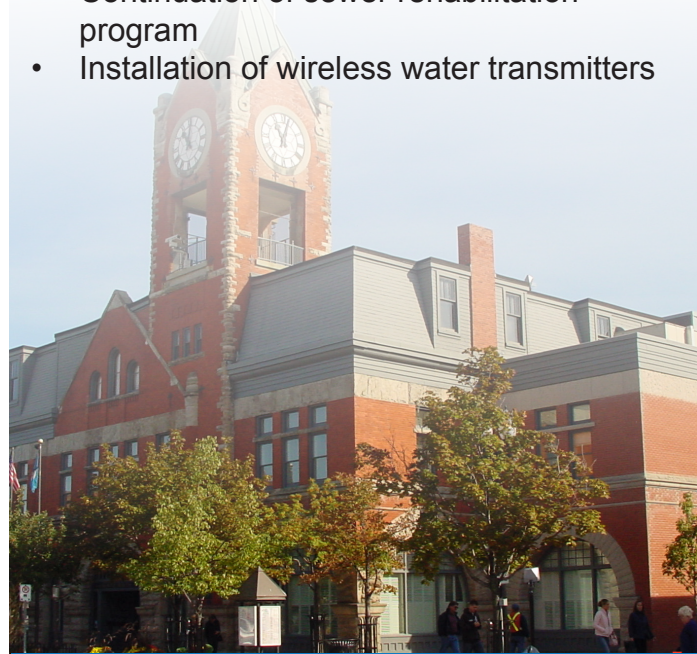

Tax Dollar Breakdown

Important Numbers

Your 2017 final property tax bill is enclosed with this notice. The total amount is payable in two installments due on August 18, 2017 and October 20, 2017. The interim tax installments, mailed in January, were due on February 17, 2017 and May 19, 2017. Your property tax bill is comprised of taxes levied by the Town of Collingwood, the County of Simcoe, and the Provincial education levies.

For 2017, Council has continued the Capital Levy, which will show as a separate line on the Municipal portion of your tax notice. This levy is the equivalent of a 0.75% tax rate increase, and will raise \$225,000 specifically for capital projects.

The education portion of your tax bill is about 15% of the total. The County portion, (including garbage collection) is about 24%. The portion collected for municipal services is about 61%, including the Capital Levy.

Your property value assessment and the names and addresses of the persons assessed, identified on your tax bill, are in accordance with the Assessment Roll. This Roll was prepared by the Municipal Property Assessment Corporation (MPAC), and is based on a January 1, 2016 valuation date. Penalties and interest

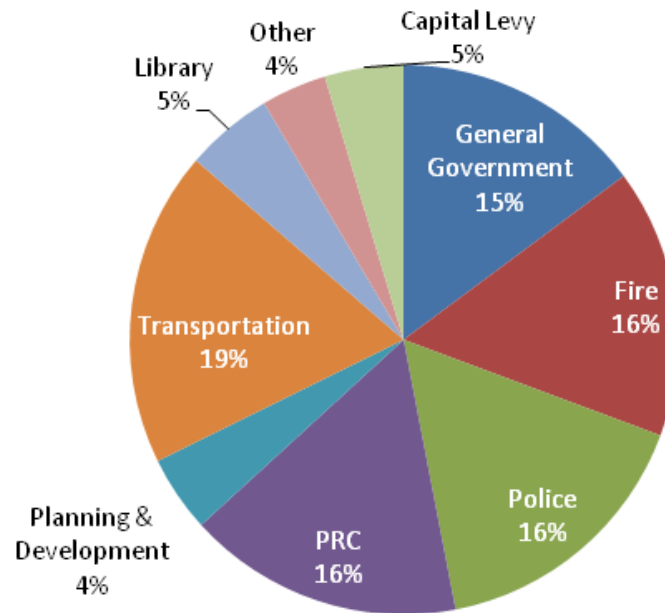
To avoid penalty and interest charges, the payment must be received by the Tax Department on or before the due date. A penalty charge of 1.25% may be added on the first day of default. Interest will be added at the rate of 1.25% on the first day of each month for as long as the account is outstanding.

Council and Town staff do not have the authority to waive or alter a penalty and/or interest charge for any reason. Failure to receive a tax bill does not excuse a taxpayer from the responsibility for payment of the taxes nor relieve the owner of the liability for the penalty or interest due to the late payment.

Based on a sample home assessed at \$200,000, the total taxes payable will be \$2,461.32, broken down as follows:

Education levy	\$ 358.00
County levy	\$ 589.07
Town levy	\$1,503.00
Capital levy	\$ 11.25
