## Become a Hero

## What you need:

- Construction paper (black, yellow, and blue)
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Camera and printer
- White pencil crayons

## How to make your superhero scene:

- 1. Get someone to take a photo of you in your best flying pose.
- 2. Print a 4" x 6" copy of the photo.
- 3. Cut out various shapes and sizes of black construction paper for your skyline.
- 4. Glue black pieces along one edge of your blue construction paper.
- 5. Cut yellow construction paper into small squares then glue to black pieces. These will be the windows in your skyline.
- 6. Cut yourself out of your photo and glue above the skyline.
- 7. Use white pencil crayon to draw moon and stars and to outline the buildings.

Tip: You can add a cape to your superhero using coloured construction paper.
